



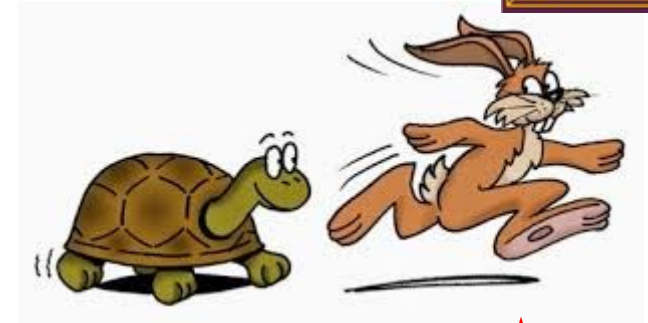
Pulse

Tempo

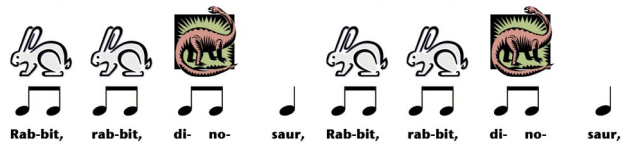
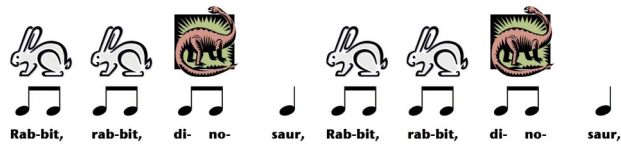


Fast or slow

Timbre

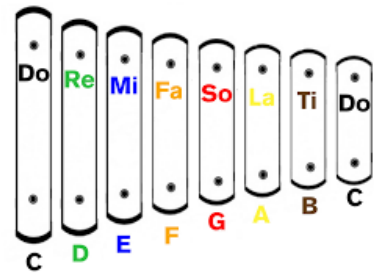
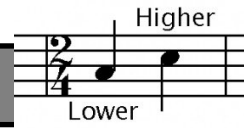
Example - Flute and Oboe

The art of directing a musical performance



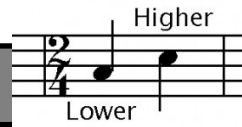
Tempo

Dynamics / Volume

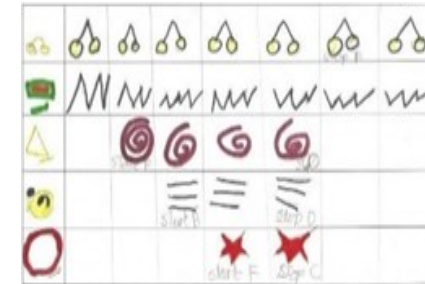
How loud or quiet a sound is
