The second phrase is heard as a direct commentary on or in response to the first.



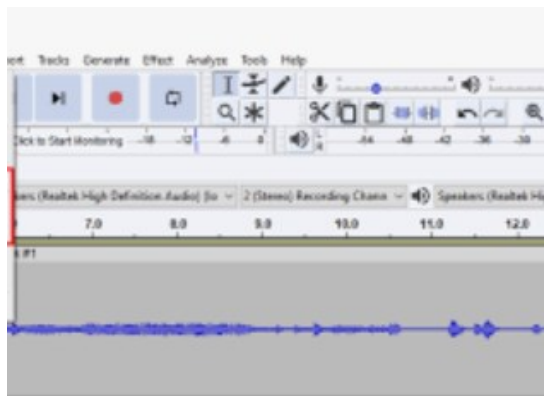
Music Technology

A device or tool used by a musician or a composer to perform music.



Graphic Score

Visual symbols used to represent music.



GarageBand: A fully equipped music creation studio.



Developed further from EYFS



Audio recording

Making a record of sound.



Genre

A style or category of music.



Groove

Rhythmic feel that makes you want to move or dance.

STROPHIC FORM

Common Example:

Deck The Halls (Christmas Carol)

(Verse 1: "Deck the Halls with boughs of holly...")

(Verse 2: "See the blazing fire before us...")

(Verse 3: "Fast away the old year passes...")

Strophic Form

A song structure in which all verses or stanzas of the text are sung to the same music.

Timbre

Example - Flute and Oboe

2 Distinctive Sounds

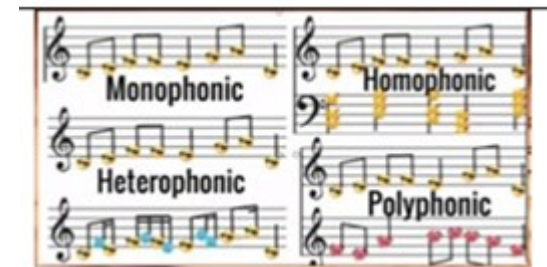
Timbre

The quality or 'colour' of sound that makes one voice or instrument differ to another.



Lyrics

The words of a song in popular Music.



Texture

The way pitch, rhythms and harmony are used in music to determine the quality of the sound.
