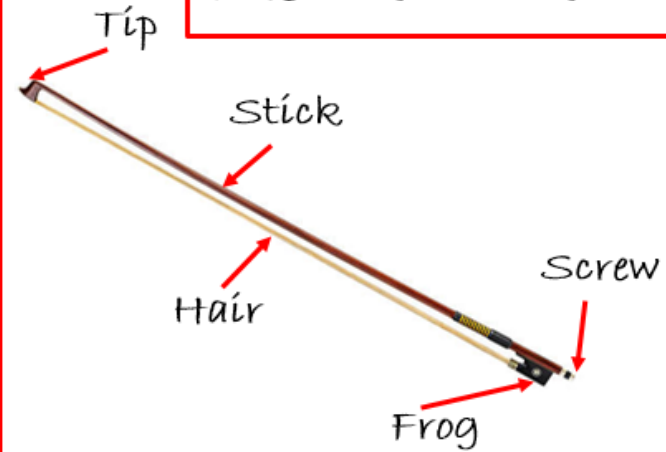




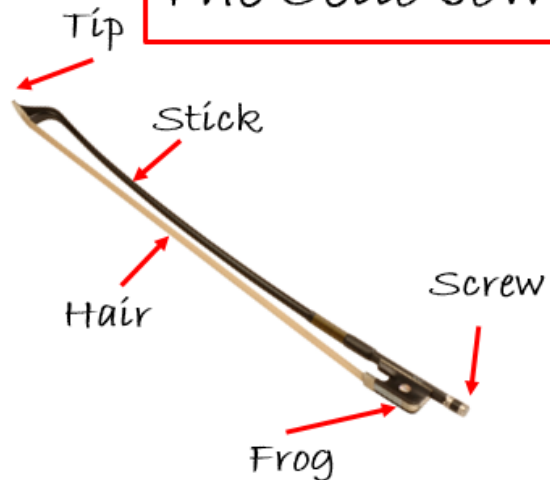

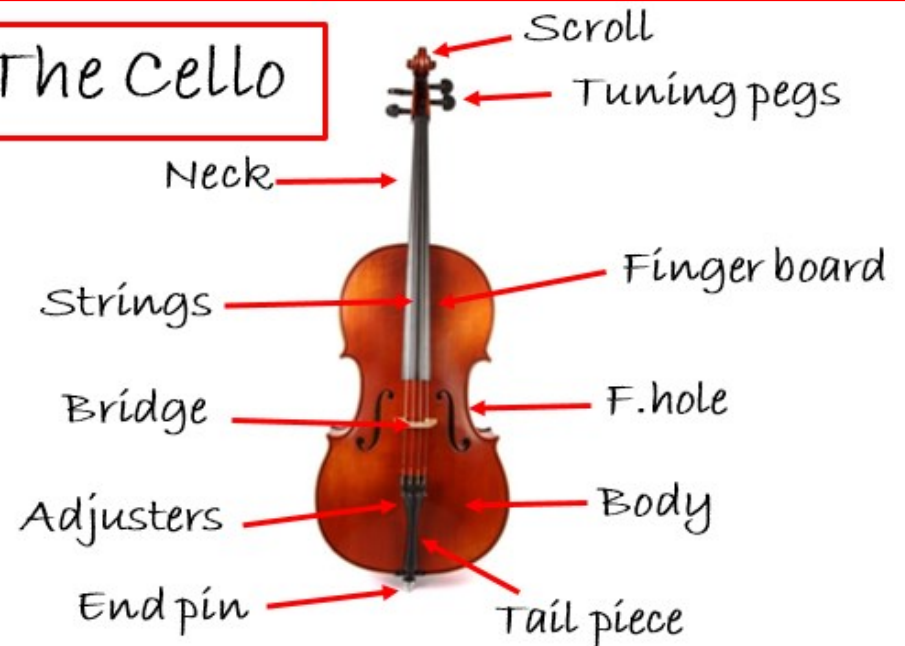
The Violin bow

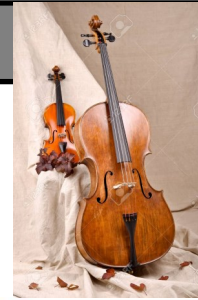


The Cello bow

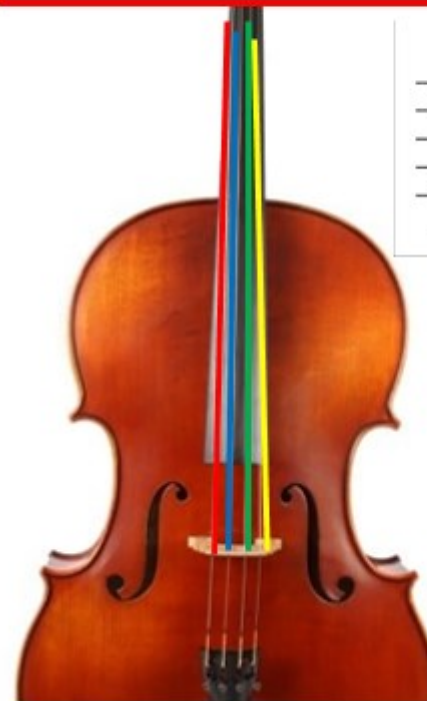

Cello strings

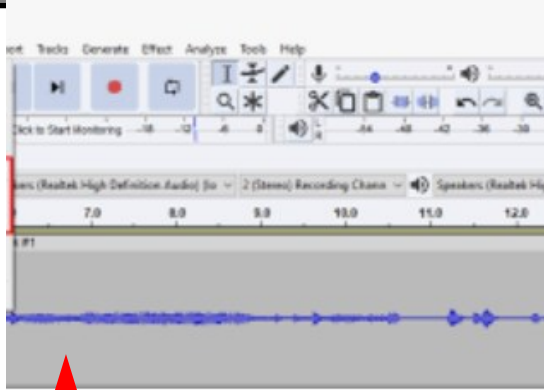


Bass clef

Song Structure

The arrangement of a song and it is part of the songwriting process.



Audio recording

Making a record of sound.



Music Technology

A device or tool used by a musician or a composer to perform music.



Intro

A song introduction, or an intro for short, is the first part of the song structure.



Drum Machine -

An electronic musical instrument that creates percussion sounds, drum beats, and patterns.



Outro -

An outro is the section that ends a song. It is the last part of the song structure.

Genre

A style or category of music.



Hi-hat

A pair of cymbals on a drum kit, that are operated using a foot pedal.



Kick Drum

A bass drum on a drum kit, that is operated using a foot pedal.



Synthesiser

An electronic musical instrument, operated with a keyboard, that can produce a wide selection of sounds.



Lyrics

The words of a song in popular Music.



Looped Samples

Short sections of music which are repeated continuously.
