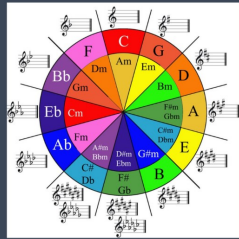




KEY SIGNATURES CHART

The bridge is a musical passage that connects two sections of a song.

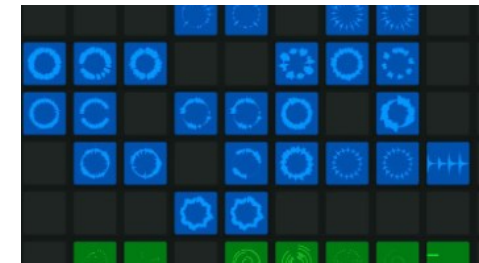


Rap

Rapping is known to be a musical form of vocal delivery that incorporates "rhyme, rhythmic speech, and everyday speech".



A social music platform that enables creators to make music and share the creative process with musicians and fans.



Loops -

pre-recorded musical phrases or riffs you can use to easily add drum beats, rhythm parts and other sounds to a project.



Dissonance

Musical notes that do not 'agree' - notes that clash.



Atonal

Music not written in any particular key.



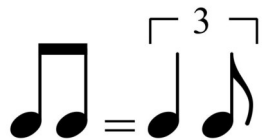
Rondo

A musical structure with a recurring theme.



Syncopation

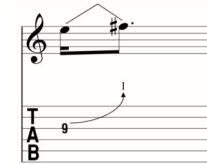
Rhythms where strong beats become weak and vice versa.



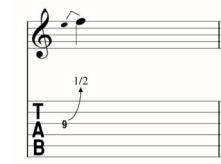
Swung Rhythms

rhythms where instead of two notes of equal length, the first note is lengthened and the second shortened.

WHOLE-STEP BEND: Strike the note and bend up one step.



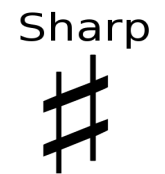
GRACE NOTE BEND: Strike the note immediately bend up as indicated.



Bent Note

A musical note that varies in pitch.

A musical note raised a semi-tone above natural pitch
