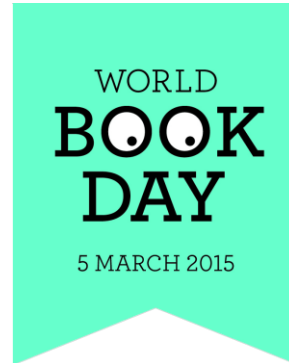
SPRING DISCO
