A super time was had by all and as always, the costumes were great! We raised £393.01 with the Readathon, many thanks again for your generosity and great efforts.

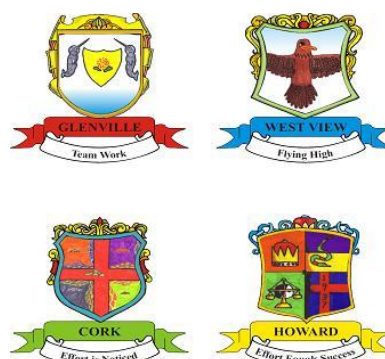
PSA updates
