<p>Using Sports Coaches with expertise in teaching.</p> <p>Teachers/Cover Supervisors will be required to <b>work alongside these coaches to plan and deliver high quality PE lessons.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• High quality P.E being delivered to all year groups. F&amp;F coach leading the teaching of P.E in Years 4+, 1, 2, 4 and 6.</li> <li>• Teachers and TA's working closely with F&amp;F coach to deliver high quality PE lessons. Confidence of Teachers and TA's receiving 'on the job' training is improving significantly.</li> <li>• F&amp;F Sports coach also running targeted sports activities for different year groups at lunchtime linked to the Sainsburys' school games competitions. High levels of participation and reduction in lunchtime incidents due to structured activities. An improvement in finishing position from last years competitions focussed on. For Example in 2015 we finished 6<sup>th</sup> in the area basketball competition out of 10 schools but finished 3<sup>rd</sup> out of 14 schools this year.</li> </ul>

We won all local leagues and the Leicestershire Rice Bowl.</li> <li>Boys Year 4/5 Football: 12 children selected main league side (4 x Yr4’s, 8 x Yr5’s). Other children will be selected to play in friendly fixtures.</li> <li>We won our area Tag-Rugby competition and represented Oadby and Wigston in the Sainsburys school games in 2019. ( Two teams of 10 pupils entered -6 girls and 14 boys from year 5 and 6)</li> <li>Girls Year 4/5 Football: 10 children (2 x Yr4’s, 8 x Yr5’s). 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|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Year 5/6 Girls Football league and Cup enter last year and this year.</li><li>• Year 6 Basketball: 14/15 – 16 children played for school. 2018-19, 8 children played (Less players as only allowed to enter 1 team into competition) This year we came 3<sup>rd</sup> out of 14 teams.</li><li>• Cross Country x3 events: Plus an area event for Oadby and Wigston. We are also organising our own paint run.</li><li>• Athletics: 2018/19 20 children entered to compete at Saffron's Lane Sports Centre in the Yr 4 &amp; 5 track and field events. Planned again 2019/20</li><li>• We enter a team into the SEN athletics event at Saffron Lane which was special event aimed at pupils with SEN. We took 6 boys to the event and won some races.</li><li>• Area Netball competition – entered last year 2014/15 team of 10 into local competition, We won and represented O &amp; W at the Sainsburys school games competition entry again planned Spring 2020. This year we have create our own league for the area and are planning to play games in the summer term.</li><li>• Dance competition – March 2019.
