	<p>This year Oadby and Wigston sports partnership set up virtual competitions due to Covid - 19. These involved teams of 10 pupils (5 boys and 5 girls) that performed a task at school and then the results were collected and ranked against other competing schools. For each of the events held, GH had many teams entered for year 5/6, 4/3 , 2/1 and SEN groups. That was over 100 pupils representing our school at each event.</p>
