Payment for Music Lessons

Extracts in bold are from Admin Memo 89 (LA)

- **All initial year Wider Opportunities lessons from a specialist teacher must be free. This is because the government has made money available for schools with KS2 children for this opportunity. All national curriculum music teaching, likewise, cannot be charged. Instrumental/vocal lessons that form an integral part of school/college examination syllabi cannot be charged.**
- **Schools can only charge for this tuition at cost – they must not make a ‘profit’.**
 - For peripatetic music lessons, fees will be charged to the parents. If the child is a LAC by the Local Authority, tuition will be free and covered by the schools private fund.
 - If the child has parent/s who are in receipt of income support, the school may fund up to 50% of the lesson payment directly to the music teacher and the school will make the appropriate parents aware of this situation.
 - Payments for lessons will vary due to length and also due to whether they are for individual or group lessons.
