



# Glen Hills Primary School Policy Statement

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## **Introduction**

The governing body is committed to ensuring that the school develops, monitors, evaluates and revises all policies necessary for the management of the school, provision of education and other activities.

The policies should provide for the needs of the pupils, parents, staff and other interested parties and set out the philosophy and principles underpinning the work of the school.

The governing body aim to ensure that all policies are based on adequate research, appropriate consultation, and should reflect good practice.

## **Adoption of policies**

All policies must be presented to the governing body for adoption and the Chair of Governors should sign and date the master copy on adoption.

## **Monitoring and review of policies**

There will be a rolling programme of policy monitoring, evaluation and review over a four year period for all policies except when a shorter time scale is specified for particular policies.

Where a policy affects others reference should be made and consultation and review sought.

Governors visits to the school will be arranged on a regular basis to monitor and review compliance with existing policies.

## **Access to policies**

All policies should be available for inspection by governors, staff parents and other authorised interested parties as a hard copy available from school. All of the policies are available on our website.
