ABSENCE AND PUNCTUALITY

As you will no doubt be aware, we are extremely keen to ensure every child has an excellent attendance at Glen Hills. By law, we are required to monitor attendance and punctuality of all of our pupils and we work closely with a private educational welfare service, Access Education, to monitor and take action if pupils have lower than 90% attendance or are continually late to school. We are really pleased that we have the vast majority of pupils who have an excellent level of attendance and punctuality but for those who have particularly high unexplained absence levels and regular punctuality problems, we have no other option than to inform Access Education who will then take further action.
