The Glen Hills Pupil Survey was carried out in November 2019. It was based on the latest Ofsted pupil survey and has been used to inform the SEF. In 4+, the teachers simplified the answers and completed the survey 1:1, recording the answers to the key questions. The rest of the school (years 1 to 6) carried out the survey either on paper or by using a Google form with minimal input from the teachers.
