We have currently £9,600 in bank but money allocated for the phonics resources have not gone out yet.

Pamper Evening - This was discussed, but unfortunately since the meeting, due to poor ticket sales this event had to be cancelled. ☹ Money to be returned to those who bought tickets.

Summer Fete – 30th June

- The event will be held with a Circus theme. To ask Kelcey to design circus theme tickets and programmes.
- At the moment 110 are having circus skills at school. Tim to ask the organiser – Steve Burrows if they would be interested in coming to the fete.
- Gina suggested we could have a Glenhills bunting to go with the theme and use at other fetes in the future. 10mtrs = £6.36 + VAT per strip. Gina to look at flags also.
- To change the name of 'Beach Bags' to LUCKY BAGS as they are more appropriate. To sort out these bags in advance.
